This wine has a bouquet of smoke, warm spices, and candied cherries; reminiscent of cherry cavendish tobacco. Medium-bodied, the red fruit shines through with bright cherry, red apple, and currants, joined by darker flavors of black tea and pepper. It finishes lightly tannic with a mild acidity that makes it refreshingly approachable.

Immediately, you are hit by a perfumed puff of cedar and flowers, but the cranberry, orange peel, and rose aromas just beneath assure you that it is definitely Sangiovese. It has a medium body, loads of red fruit, and a touch of candied cherry. That candied perception is quickly washed away, however, with a lingering, balanced finish. This is, after all, a serious Sangiovese, made in a technique that respects the grape and its heritage.

Lightly floral and full of candied cherry, raspberry coulis, and vanilla custard, the bouquet is fruit-forward with the promise of a bright and lively experience on the palate. As promised, this wine dances across your tongue with succulent cherry, as toasted coconut lends a round mouthfeel. It finishes like biting into a ripe raspberry, a burst of flavor and tartness that lingers into the next sip.

Vineyard Timeline

- 1997 Purchased property and removed Cattle; Contracted with Wente to plant grapes
- 1998 Wente planted & managed 3 acres: Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Barbera
- 1999 Planted Kalamata Olive Oil trees
- 2000 Harvested Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, & Barbera to hone winemaking skills
- 2000 Applied for permit with ATF
- 2004 Bottled 1 st wine to be sold and Tasting Room is opened in October
- 2007 Started the Wine Club
- 2010 Grafted Barbera onto the Cabernet Sauvignon vines
- 2010 Bought first commercial size crusher and press
- 2012 Added Barbera vines along the driveway and along the front fence line
- 2015 Pulled Sangiovese and replaced with Petit Verdot (1 st bottled vintage is 2013 per ACS)
- 2016 Replaced Cabernet Sauvignon vines
- 2018 Contracted our current winemaker, Meredith Sarboraria
- 2020 Planted more Cabernet Sauvignon, added Nebbiolo and Dolcetto to vineyard
- 2022 Planted Nebbiolo & Dolcetto
- 2023 1 st Harvest of our Fiano, Dolcetto and Nebbiolo
- 2024 Pulled some Barbera and planted Cabernet Franc; pulled Cabernet Sauvignon and planted Malbec
- 2024 Wine Enthusiast gave all of our entered wines over 90 points!
